## What is this gathering about?

This event is catered to investigators based in North Carolina and Virginia who want take their skills to the next level. Many para-events feature well-known personalities. This symposium is a little different in that the focus is on *investigators and investigation*. There are no famous folks (although we love them) and no ghost hunts -- just education and dialogue with like-minded colleagues.

## What is Körner's Folly?

Built in 1878 by eccentric Jule Körner, this home includes 22 rooms spread between seven floors. At the top is Cupid's Park, what many believe to be America's first community theater. No room or doorway is alike, and 80% of the furnishings are original to the house – and designed by jovial Mr. Körner. Dubbed as America's Strangest House for its unprecedented character and design, Körner's Folly is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places. ## Paranormal Activity?

There were always stories, but no solid evidence existed until the first investigation in 2009. Körner's Folly seems to be consistently active. Most teams have captured what is believed to be residual and intelligent EVP, documented personal experiences, equipment failure, measurable cold spots, light anomalies, and shadow play.

The house has a whimsical, Willy Wonka type of appeal, and most suggest this location is a “happy haunt.” Körner's Folly has received extensive local media coverage regarding its spirit layer, and provides a great case study showcasing how public paranormal interest can benefit historic
