Haunted North Carolina Presents  
“**Hauntings Through History**”

*With Haunted North Carolina members, Iris Carter and Missi Brandewie*

Missi Brandewie of Haunted North Carolina will explore historical locations with paranormal activity and the people who have been "hunting" ghosts for over 150 years. It begins with ghost hunting origins in England, but quickly returns stateside to Abraham Lincoln's experiences and the White House. Missi provides evidence obtained at various historical locations, including Glenfiddich in Northern Virginia and the USS Battleship North Carolina

**Iris Carter**, also a member of Haunted North Carolina, was part of the Körner's Folly investigation in May 2009 that put the property on the paranormal map. She will provide a brief report of evidence obtained at subsequent Körner's Folly investigations.

The program will run about an hour, not including Q & A.
